

Licensing is based on first come first serve basis when applying for green fields. However, the Government shall conduct competitive bidding rounds for select brown fields. Uganda has 13 (Thirteen) types of licenses which include:

- 1. Prospecting License(PL)
- 2. Exploration License(EL)
- 3. Retention License(RL)
- 4. Artisanal Mining License(AML)
- 5. Small Scale Mining License(SML)
- 6. Medium Scale Mining License (MML)
- 7. Large Scale Mining License(LML)
- 8. License for Extraction for Direct Use of Geothermal Resources
- 9. Mineral Processing license (MPL)
- 10. Mineral Refining license (MRL)
- Mineral Smelting License (MSL)
- 12. Mineral Dealers license(MDL)
- 13. Gold Smith License (GSL) and many other permits











#### **LAW**


Uganda's legal system is a combination of common and civil law including codified statutes jurisprudence, precedent from case law, and recognition of customary (indigenous) law. The supreme law in the country is the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda 1995 (as amended), which vests minerals in the Government on behalf of the Republic of Uganda. The primary law is the Mining and Minerals Act, Cap.159 and regulations are made under that Act currently including:

- •Mining and Minerals (Licensing) Regulations 2023
  •Mining and Minerals (Export and Import of Tin purity levels) Regulations 2024
- •Mining and Minerals (Export of Refined Gold) Regulations 2024. and the
- •International Conference of the Great Lakes Region (Implementation of the Pact on Security Stability and Development in the Great Lakes Region)(Prevention of Illegal Exploitation and Illicit Trade in Designated Minerals) Regulations 2023.


Other relevant laws include all the statutes on Environment, Land, Labour, Forests, Water, and Taxes.




Laws of Uganda 2024 portal




# **UGANDA'S MINERAL PRODUCTION STATISTICS**


